Key Stage 2 (Number of pupil 60)

National tests (SATs) in Reading, Maths and Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling to assess each child's attainment and standard. Writing is assessed by the team of Year 6 teachers in school using each child's work over the year and their judgements verified by external moderators.

DfE (Department of Education) Progress measures KS1-KS2

Reading (school)	+0.74	Range -0.9 to +2.3
Writing (school)	+1.30	Range -0.2 to +2.8
Maths (school)	+0.43	Range -1.0 to +1.8

The progress made by our Year 6 children as they moved through Years 3-6 is shown by the above measures. Any positive figure shows greater than expected progress.

Progress:

From 2016 schools will be held to account for the percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard at the end of KS2 and whether they make sufficient progress based on a new, value-added measure of progress.

Progress measures for 2017 will work in a similar way to primary value-added measures. A school's score will be calculated by comparing their pupils' KS2 results against those of all pupils nationally who had similar starting points.

Pupils will be assigned to prior attainment groups based on their KS1 results. These groups are based on pupils' combined KS1 scores in reading, writing and maths

The department confirms what score a school would need to get to have made "sufficient progress" after the tests have been completed and all the results have been received.

In 2017 the **sufficient progress** measures were set by the government at -5 for reading, -5 for maths and -7 for writing.
