School Meals:



This week we are sending out further information about the upcoming changes to school meals. Each child will be sent home with further information from our new provider, Dolce, including a parent information leaflet, details of their payment system and a copy of the summer term menu.

The price of school meals will remain unchanged at £2.30 per day (£11.50 per week) and there will be the same flexibility of ordering that currently exists. You are free to order meals in advance using their system and children can also order on the morning they wish to take the meal.

You can also record any allergies that your child has and these will ensure that any meals containing these ingredients will not be made available to them.

Many parents will have made payments into Scopay for school meals already. Any funds on your Scopay accounts will be credited directly to your new Dolce account so please don't feel pressured into trying to use up any Scopay credit before half-term.

For reference, when we return after half term it will be **Week 2** on the menu

A reminder that we are a completely nut-free school, so please ensure that all food products you send in for packed lunches or snacks do not contain any nuts or nut products.
